



## Rifle Hunters Equipment List

Backpack or Fanny pack  
Flashlight or head lamp  
Binoculars  
Camera  
Toothbrush/toothpaste  
Raingear  
Gloves (I usually wear heavy knit wool)  
Orange vest  
Comfortable shoes with good ankle support, gore-tex or waterproof  
Warm boots that are good for walking  
Warm hat and light hat  
Wind proof clothing (wind sheer fleece)  
Good long underwear  
Good, thick wool or wool blend socks (cabelas outfitter heavyweights are great)

We will be staying in a restored log cabin with electric heat and hot running water. Beds with sheets/blankets and pillows will be provided, a pair of warm slippers are great on a frosty morning. The weather can be anywhere from 60 degrees and sunny to 15 below zero, snowing, and a 40 mile per hour wind. It is usually windy, wind proof fleece is great, also layered clothing that can be shed through out the day works well. We will be hunting from a boat, 4-wheel drive, or on foot right from the cabin. We will handle all packing and meat and care for your cape and head. There is an excellent taxidermist locally or we can arrange shipping if you have a favorite.
